Earlier this year, People Incorporated's Family Support Center initiated a meaningful new venture by enacting their "Transition Program." In accordance with the Family Support Center's goal to support individuals and their families with the resources they need for a fulfilling life, the Transition Program strives to offer services specifically aimed toward DDS-eligible young adults who have recently turned 22 years old or will soon turn 22 years old.



The recently implemented program offers cooking classes, craft nights, bingo nights, movie screenings, and

shopping at the Dartmouth Mall, gaming at Dave & Buster's, out to lunch at the Super Buffet, with plenty more outings and events scheduled for the future (including a May trip to Fenway for a Sox game). Though the new group is modestly sized in its current iteration, the program is expected to grow. Through the Family Support Center's Transition Program, individuals will be able to bolster their support systems and expand their networking groups.
